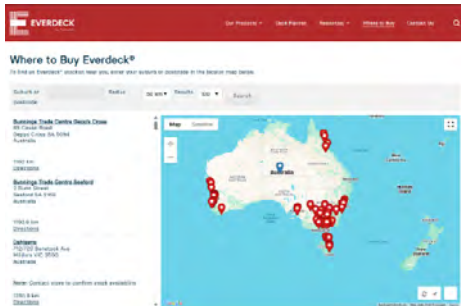

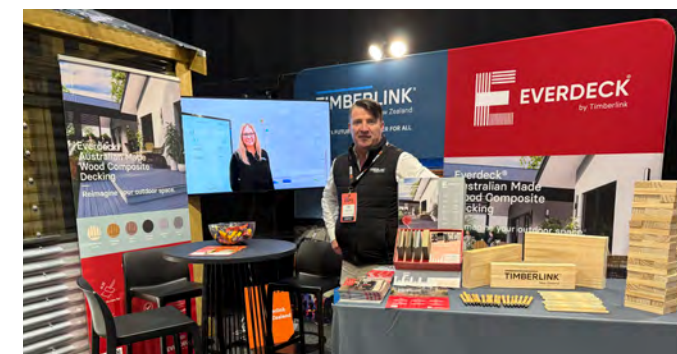

Most of my time outside of work is spent studying, but apart from that I love gaming, baking, and going to the beach.

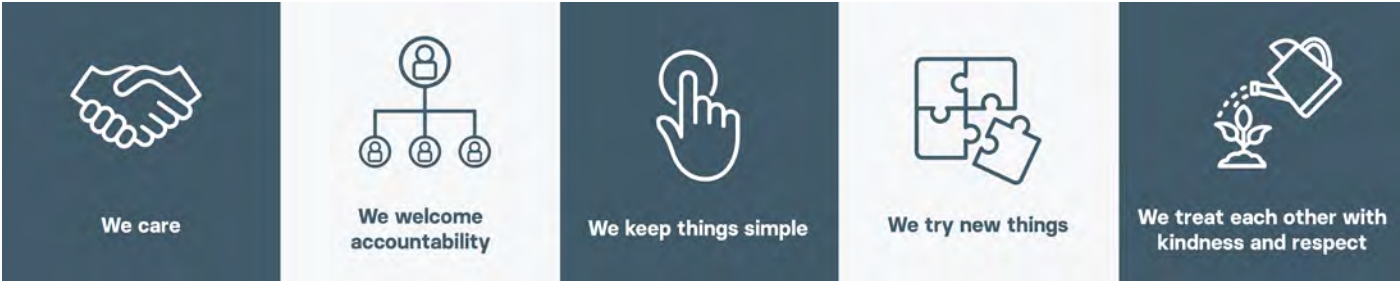
What's your favourite TV show at the moment?

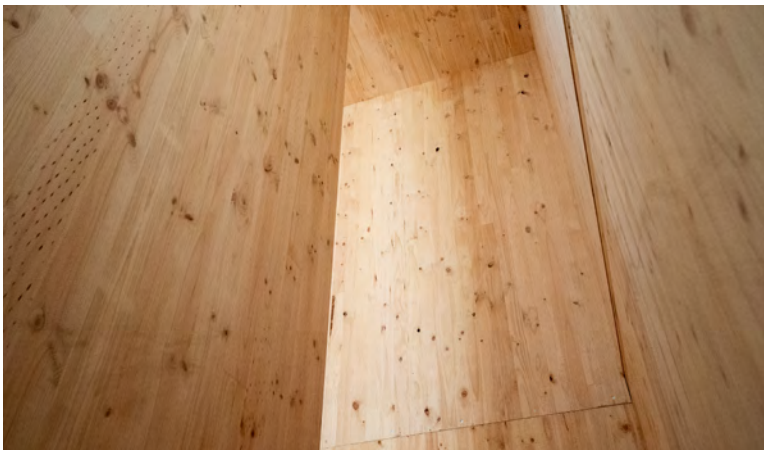

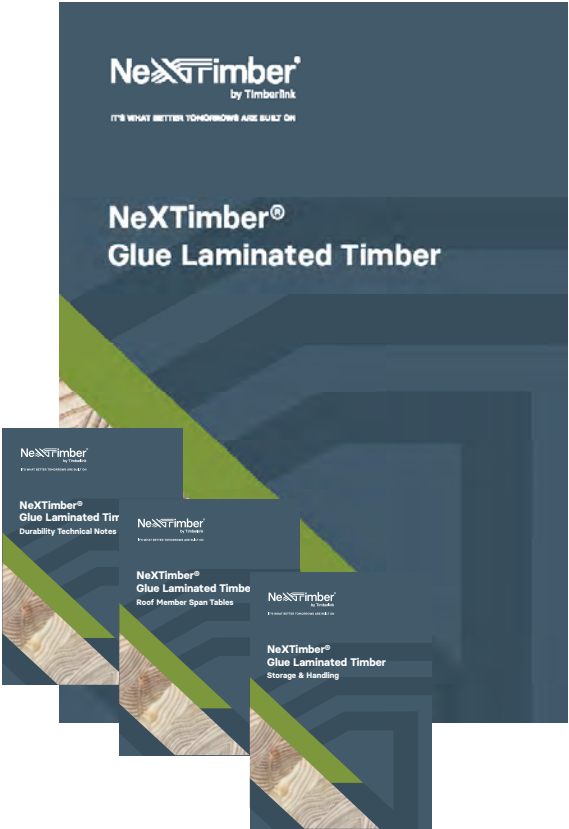

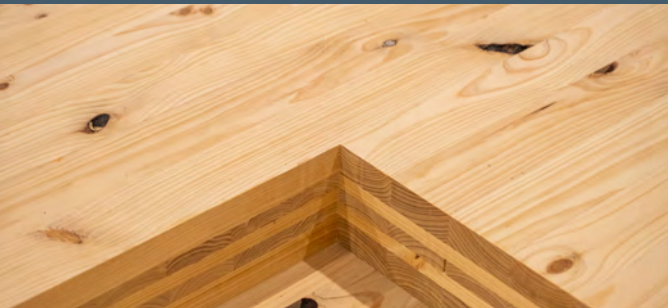
