Please be advised that all Timberlink Australia branded MGP10, MGP12 and MGP15 stress-graded structural timber is produced using a process compliant with Australian/New Zealand Standards AS/NZS 1748.1:2011 and AS/NZS 1748.2:2011. Product properties are verified as compliant to the requirements of AS 1720.1:2010 under the requirements of AS/NZS 4490:2011.

Timberlink's two manufacturing facilities are certified by the Engineered Wood Products Association of Australasia (EWPAA) as operating quality control systems that meet the requirements of the EWPAA Product Certification Scheme with product certified to AS/NZS 1748:2011 Solid Timber - Stress-Graded for Structural Purposes. Tarpeena is mill number 558, and Bell Bay is 704.
